- Having only air drier to dry hands in bathrooms.

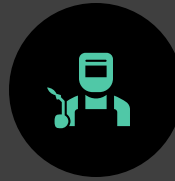
Other Solutions

-Buy precooked bacon/find a better way to cook bacon



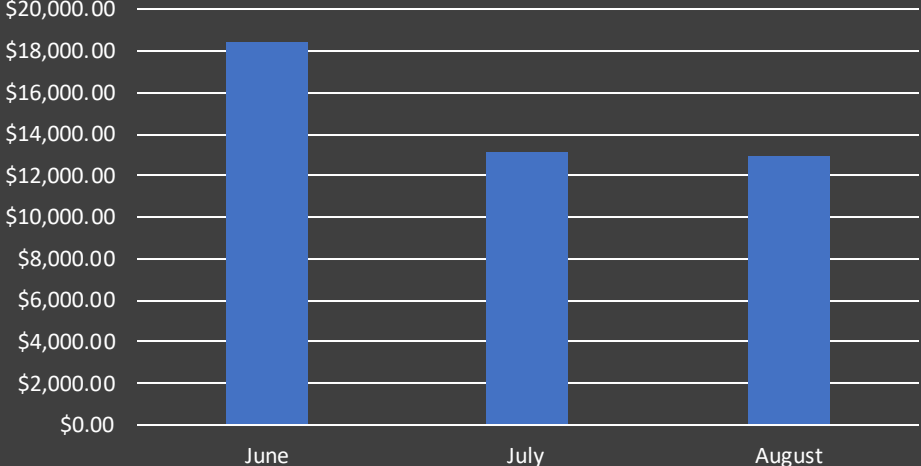
-Aim for right orders the first time to reduce waste



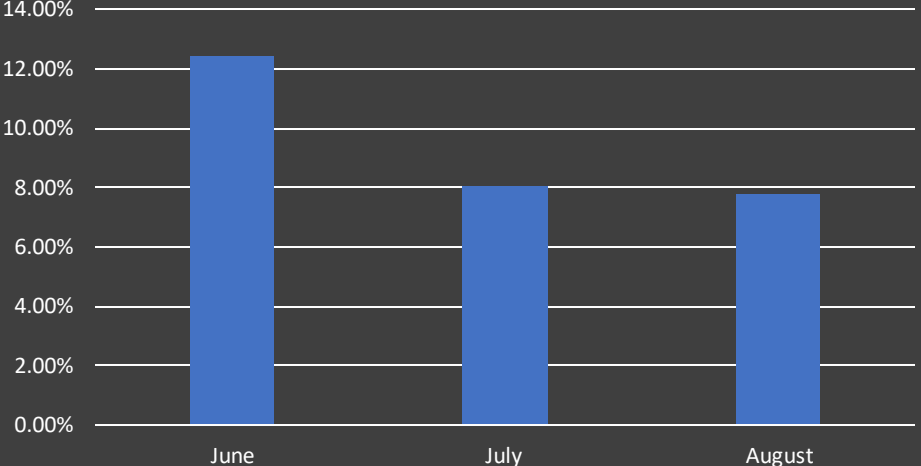
-Close and clean constantly to reduce contamination and waste of good products.

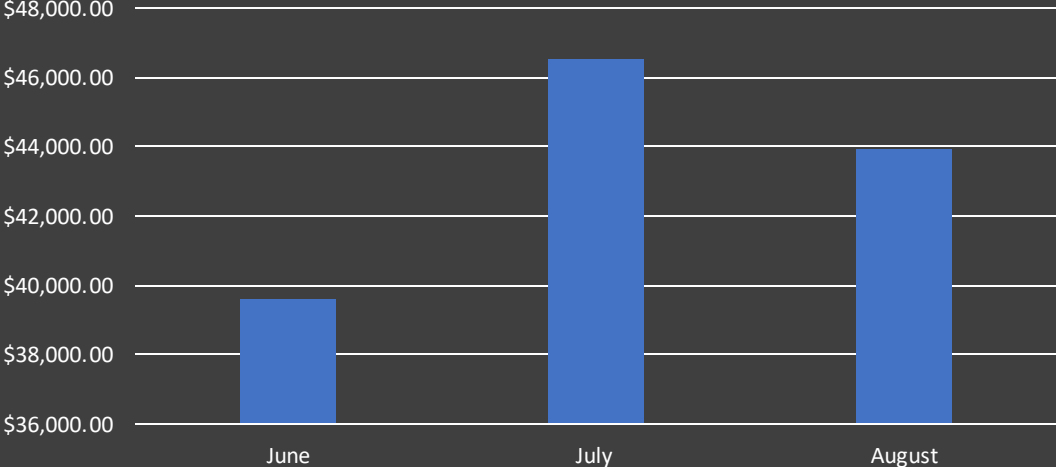
Operating Income
